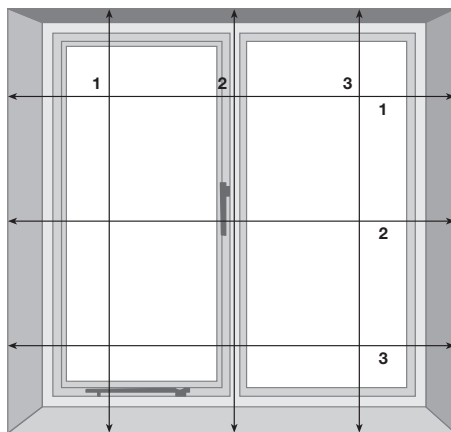


roman blinds

measuring instructions

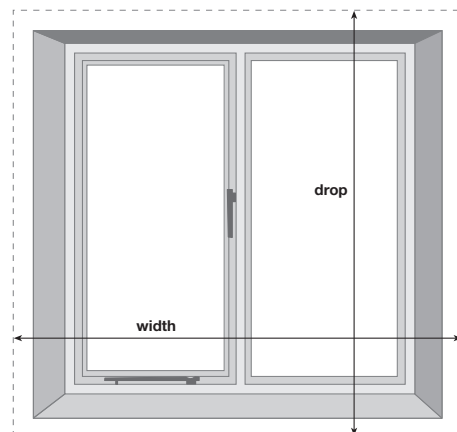
For accurate measurements please use a metal tape measure, and take measurements in centimetres, to the nearest 0.1cm.

- All of our blinds can be fixed into the face of the window frame or wall, or into the top of the lintel - allowing you total control of the depth your blind can be positioned in the depth of your window recess.
- Choose whether you want the blinds to hang inside or outside the window recess.
- Please check for the proximity of adjacent walls, furniture, window handles etc. when measuring for your blinds.



Recess

For blinds to hang inside the window recess:
Measure the drop by taking the measurement from the top of the recess to the window sill, in three places as shown. Measure the width of the window recess from wall to wall, in three places as shown. Take the smallest measurement. We will make all adjustments to ensure your blinds fit perfectly.



Exact

For blinds to hang outside the window recess:
Measure the exact area you would like the blind to cover as shown.

aftercare

Look after your blinds by following the straightforward operating instructions below.

Operating Instructions

- Pull the cords to raise the blind to the desired level.
- Then tie the cord around the cleat (if fitting Standard Roman blind).

Cleaning

- The fabric can be removed from the headrail and the rods removed, but should be dry cleaned with care only. (P)
- Soft fabric will shrink - if any of the fibre rods become visible trim off to the desired length with an appropriate tool.
- As an alternative to dry cleaning, the blind can be cleaned using the upholstery tool on your vacuum cleaner.
